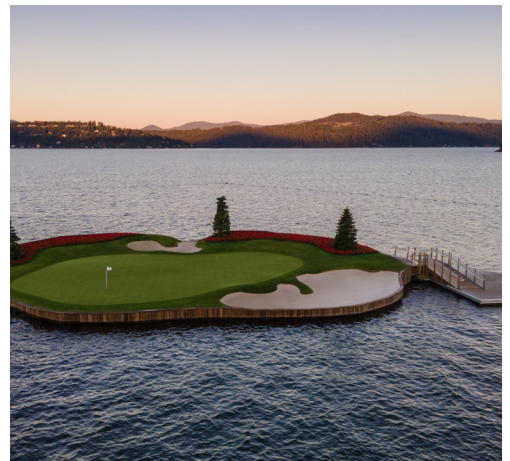
# This one is for the books

Our Welcome Reception will be held at the resort on Monday at 6:00 PM with some light appetizers and drinks. We are hoping it will be just in time for the sunset!

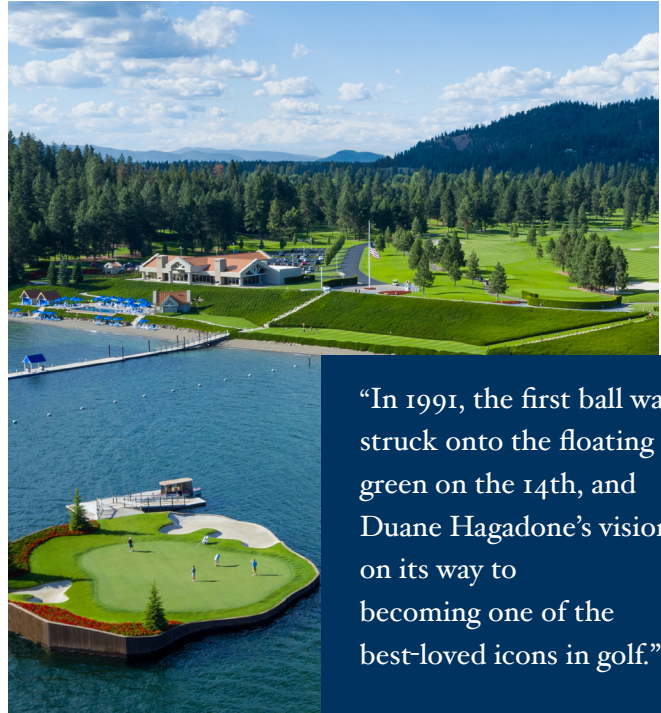
