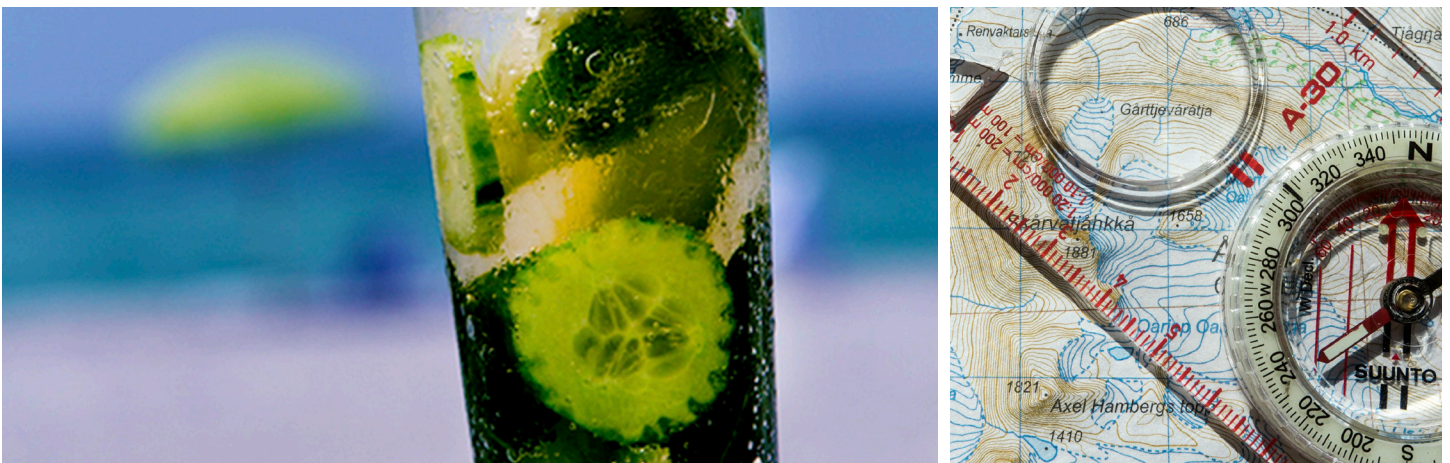


You Don't Want to Miss This
